

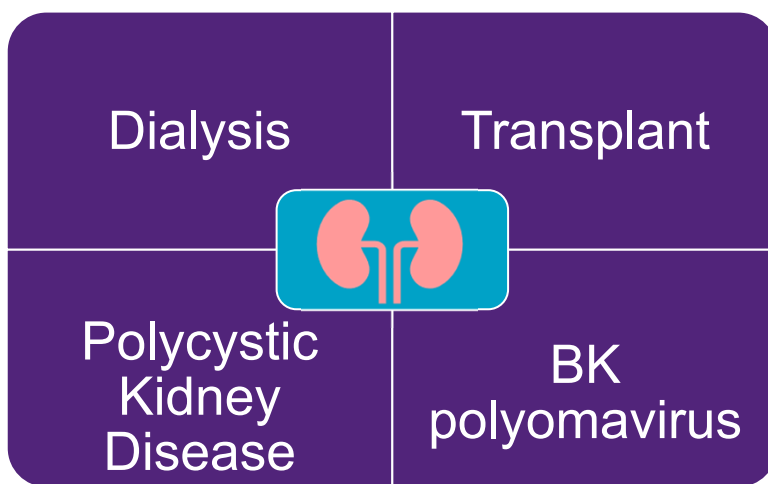
Do you have experience with kidney disease?
