Involving Consumers

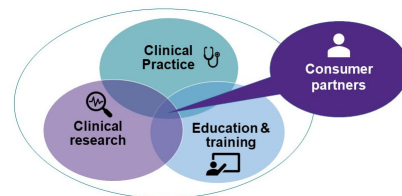
